PROPOSED NAIROBI EXPRESSWAY TOLL OPTIMIZATION AND UPGRADING PROJECT STAKEHOLDER AND PUBLIC CONSULTATION FORUMS

The Kenya National Highways Authority and Moja Expressway Company intend to undertake enhancements and improvements works on the Nairobi Expressway to accommodate the growing traffic. These upgrades will involve the addition of extra lanes at the Museum Hill Exit and the JKIA Entrance and construction of a new Haile Selassie Toll Station Exit to facilitate the seamless flow of traffic into the CBD.

Centric Africa Limited has been appointed to prepare the Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) for the upgrade works. As part of the preparation process, Kenya National Highways Authority plans to hold public consultation /stakeholders consultative meetings in conformity to the provisions of the Constitution of Kenya and Environmental Management and Coordination Act (EMCA) Cap 387.
