



PUBLIC NOTICE

Welcome to the Nairobi Expressway. Moja Expressway Company will illustrate the safety tips of the Nairobi Expressway.

1. Safety while driving

- 1.1 Strictly observe the laws and regulations of Kenya as outlined in **KENYA TRAFFIC ACT CAP 403**. Be safe and drive smart.
- 1.2 The Nairobi Expressway is fully fenced. Pedestrians, livestock, non-motorised vehicles, motorcycles, tricycles, tractors, crawlers, loaders, and forklifts are not allowed on the Nairobi Expressway.
- 1.3 Do not stop or allow any people to get on or off your vehicle on the Nairobi Expressway to avoid obstruction, inconvenience or danger to other road users. Do not drive on or occupy the emergency lane except in the event of an emergency.
- 1.4 If you miss the planned exit, please proceed to the next Toll Station to exit the Nairobi Expressway. No reversals or U-turns are allowed.
- 1.5 Drive at the prescribed speed limit (maximum 80Km/h) shown by the traffic signs on the Nairobi Expressway. It is illegal to organize or take part in any race or speed test on the Nairobi Expressway.
- 1.6 Overloading is not allowed. In case you need to drive an oversized load vehicle on the Nairobi Expressway, you are required to submit an application to the Nairobi Expressway Plaza at least 3 days in advance.
- 1.7 Do not drive fatigued at any time or while under the influence of alcohol or drugs to such an extent that you are incapable of having proper control of the vehicle. The driver of any vehicle should be highly attentive to their driving and take due care of the safety of other

road users. Do not engage in potentially distracting actions while driving, such as using mobile phones or smoking, etc.

- 1.8 For all the road users' safety, please do not litter in any manner on or off the Nairobi Expressway, this is a very dangerous and deadly act.
- 1.9 In the unlikely event of an accident on the Nairobi Expressway, do not panic. Turn on your hazard light, evacuate all the people in the vehicle and stand at a safe distance outside the barrier. Place a warning sign 150m from the vehicle against the direction of traffic flow and call the **Nairobi Expressway Hotline on 0111 039 888**.
- 1.10 For safe and convenient transit on the Nairobi Expressway, please follow the established traffic signs strictly and obey the instructions and requirements of the Nairobi Expressway management.

2. Protection of Expressway Property

For your safety, please join us to protect the property of the Nairobi Expressway.

The following activities are prohibited within the Nairobi Expressway:

- 2.1 Construction without permission.
- 2.2 Rearing and herding livestock on and along the Nairobi Expressway.
- 2.3 Setting up stalls, parking, stacking, dumping waste, and blocking ditches under the bridges.
- 2.4 Setting up billboards without prior authorization.
- 2.5 Stealing and damaging property of the Nairobi Expressway.
- 2.6 Graffiti and scribbling on the Nairobi Expressway property or any other facilities.
- 2.7 Other activities causing damage to the Nairobi Expressway.

3. Caution

Any damage to the property and any infringement on the rights of the Nairobi Expressway are subject to indemnification in accordance with the compensation standard.

Monitoring cameras are installed throughout the Nairobi Expressway. All violation of the set rule, regulations and provisions mentioned above will be recorded and prosecuted.
